An Elm Street Project

On behalf of the Elm Street committee of South Side Local Development Company and the South Side Slopes Neighborhood Association, you are cordially invited to attend the rededication ceremony of the **Pius Street Memorial on Tuesday, September 11, 2007 at 6:30pm.**

The Pius Street Memorial was created in the late 1940's by American Legion Hillside Post 875. Located in the heart of the South Side Slopes Neighborhood and the Elm Street District, the memorial honors those from the neighborhood "who served their Country during all wars." Improvements to the site were one of the first designated for the South Side Slopes Elm Street district. The result is a revitalized space complete with new landscaping, sidewalks and wrought iron fencing.

Following the ceremony, the South Side Slopes Neighborhood Association will hold its monthly general meeting in the auditorium of the Veronica's Veil Players where Mayor Luke Ravenstahl will be the guest speaker. Refreshments will be served.
