CITY CODE 419.09

It is the responsibility of every property owner, tenant, and business to keep the City of Pittsburgh clean and vibrant. Businesses, landlords, and tenants must share in their responsibility to keep our city clean, safe, and healthy. The City of Pittsburgh can no longer turn a blind eye and wait for you to respond to the continuing litter that accumulates in front of your property, especially on weekends. Under City Code 419.09 you are required to keep your store fronts and properties clean of trash, leaves, graffiti and litter. The effort is minimal and results can be tremendous to our city and neighborhood.

To those who are doing their part, we appreciate it, For those who are not, you may consider this notice your final warning. Inspectors will be patrolling the city to manage this issue including weekends and will cite properties that are non-compliant.

Please do what's right so we don't have to cite!
